Future work, help needed:

- Pour footings, one person to assist with leveling and troweling the footings.
- Dry stack block, 2-4 people to lay up concrete block.
- Put up stone veneer, 5-6 people. Any masonry experience is helpful. If not experienced, you can be trained.
- Build timber truss rafters in the flat prior to transport to job site. 2-4 people.
- Staining Truss Rafters after assembly and prior to erection. 2-4 people.
