All proceeds benefit the charitable work of the Brainerd Rotary Club and its partner organizations.

Mission:

The primary mission of the foundation shall be to further the development and/or addition of curricular, co-curricular, and extra-curricular programs of demonstrable value and to provide an enriching and quality experience for student in grades Pre-K through 12 located in the Brainerd Lakes area. The Board of Directors, at its discretion, may participate in other local, national, and international projects of a charitable or educational nature.

Projects Funded

The Brainerd Rotary Foundation will grant funds based on the following criteria:

- Does it address a need for Pre-K through 12 in the Brainerd Lakes Area?
- Is it a project that is "Uniquely Rotary?"
- Does the project have active Rotary member involvement and support.
- Will the project have a meaningful impact by our grant?
- Would the project not otherwise be able to continue without our support?
- Does it address the critical "social needs" of our community?

Application Deadlines

The Brainerd Rotary Foundation considers grant requests monthly. Application needs to be submitted at least two weeks prior to our meeting date. Brainerd Rotary Foundation meets the second Tuesday of every month.

In order for a grant request to be considered, it must be received before the Application Deadline.
